1. Read Deut 5:6, what does the verse tell us about God? How this verse help us to understand the 10 commandments?

2. How can God's love, grace, and redemption make his commands not feel burdensome but joy? Do you see God's commandments as loving principles that lead to abundance of life instead of crushing burdens?

2. How can the 10 Commandments be summarized? What does that mean in your own words? What purpose do 10 commandments have for New Testament believers?

3. How do you apply 1-3 commandments in your life? Each person takes turn to share from your own understanding...

4. Why is it important to keep 4th commandment in our busy life style? Do you see this commandment as an expression of God's love and care for us? Why? Share your experience?

5. What should be your motivation and empowerment for keeping His commandments?
Do you see the benefits of these commandments in your life and your everyday living?

6. Which of the commandments in Deuteronomy 5 are the hardest for you to keep? What should we do to overcome? (Individual and also as a CG family).

7. Pray for one another;

- Thank God for redeeming you from slavery and leading you through the wilderness of life, then commit to follow him in the strength that he provides.
- Ask God to convince you of his authority (so that you will obey his commands) and ask him to convince you of his love (so that you will submit with joy).
