DISCUSSION QUESTIONS ON MICAH 6:8

A. TO DO JUSTICE

1. Why is “acting justly” something God desires for his children? What does it communicate to our neighbours when we do or when we don’t?
2. Corruption, evil and injustice are rampant in our society. Does this fact shake your faith? How does it influence the way you view God?
3. For the Christian, where does God’s grace and His justice meet? Why is it important that we remember the cross?

B. TO LOVE KINDNESS

4. What does it mean to “love kindness?” How should our hearts respond when we are given the opportunity to show kindness?
5. What is the relationship between kindness and forgiveness? Does kindness mean “forgive and forget”?
6. How does kindness give us an opportunity to influence our neighbours?

C. TO WALK HUMBLY WITH GOD

7. Based upon Micah 6:8, what is a proper definition of humility?

8. What are the differences in attitude shown by the Pharisee and the tax collector? (Luke 18:10-14)

9. In 1 Peter 5:5, why does God oppose the proud so strongly? Why is there no room for pride in the Christian's life?

APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

In what ways could your group participate in an activity or ministry that:

- (a) fights for justice and mercy for underprivileged groups?

- (b) that encourages faithfulness and humility among Christians?

- (c) that reaches out to nonbelievers or the less fortunate in your community?

Would you, as a group, commit to seeking out and acting on at least one of these opportunities this month?
