Injustice and Evil under the Sun | Eccl 3:16-4:3 | Dr George Tee

1. To what degree does Solomon find justice under the sun? Why are even the public courts for justice not capable of establishing true justice in this world? Why does God delay His bringing of final justice until sometime in the future?
2. When have you recently seen or experienced a travesty of justice? How did you deal with this observation or experience? When others face injustice how do you provide comfort? When you are asked to explain the reasons for injustice, how do you respond?
3. What role does God's judgment play in injustice and wickedness (3: 17)? How does God's judgment comfort and encourage us? Read 2 Cor 5: 10 and Rev 20: 11-15.
4. How does injustice in life remind me of my human limitations and frailties (3: 18-21)? Explain what does man have in common with beasts? What effect does this have on my present life in this world?
5. Have you experienced oppression before (4: 1-3)? When you observed others being oppressed, either directly or indirectly, describe how would you respond to their predicament? Describe a real-life situation how you are instrumental in bringing some respite and comfort to the pains of the oppressed.
6. Some refugees in Malaysia suffered injustice and oppression in their home countries (you may use asylum seekers from Myanmar such as Chin, Karen and Mon as your reference). What do you think should be the correct Christian response towards those who suffered injustice and oppression? (use Scriptural references to support your answer) What are some of the ways, you, as an individual and PBC, as a church could play a role to make a difference in their lives?
