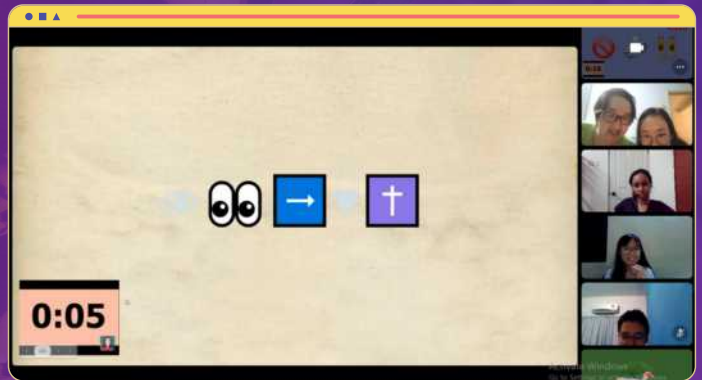
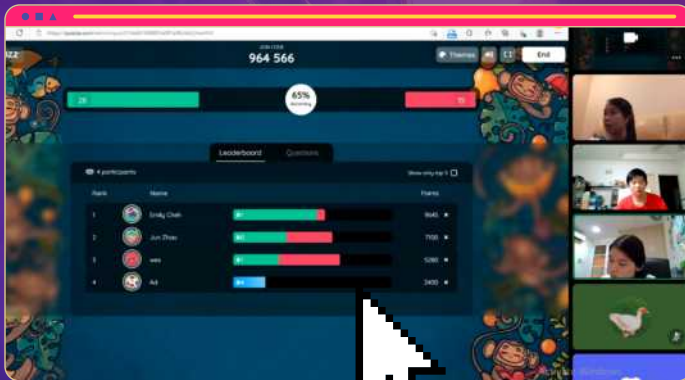
Valentine's Day
