Living with the current omicron wave.

We have all endured the pandemic for two years now. The current wave with cases hovering around 26,000 to 28,000 per day is causing some anxiety amongst our church members. The MOH acknowledges that we are now facing the Omicron wave that is spreading very fast, so the number of cases may go even higher. As we have seen in western countries this spike will also decline fast after it peaks.

Unlike Delta, the Omicron variant will result in milder symptoms for those with full vaccination including the booster jab.

Because Omicron is easily transmissible many of us can be infected. Many of us can also be close contacts and casual contacts. FOR CASUAL CONTACTS.

Many of you are asking "What do I do when a casual contact notice appears on MySejahtera?"

Stay calm. Do not panic. Update your health status in the App. There are no specific restrictions by MOH if you are a casual contact. If you decide to come to church on Sunday, please do a self-test on Saturday night. You may attend church if your test is negative.

However, if you experience mild symptoms, you should not attend church even though your test is negative.

We continue to pray for protection from our great and mighty God and as responsible Christians, we must follow strictly the covid SOP.
