Remember your Creator| Ecclesiastes 11:7-12:8 | Pr Wallace Ong

1. Read 11:7-8. How are we to live, knowing our life "under the sun" will end in darkness (death and hell)? How can these verses alert us? (v7:2, v7:4-5, v7:11-12, Proverbs 1:7, Proverbs 4:3-13, Ecc 5:18-20)

2. Read 11:9-10. How are we to live, knowing "for all these things God will bring thee into judgment."? How can these verses alert us? (v12:13-14)

Ecc 11:9-10 (KJV) - 9 Rejoice, O young man, in thy youth; and let thy heart cheer thee in the days of thy youth, and walk in the ways of thine heart, and in the sight of thine eyes: but know thou, that for all these things God will bring thee into judgment. 10 Therefore remove sorrow from thy heart, and put away evil from thy flesh: for childhood and youth are vanity.

3. Should Christians enjoy life and be happy? Why? (Ecc 2:24-26, Ecc 5:18-20)

4. What lessons can we learn from verses vv7-10? What is the Teacher's warning?

5. Read Ecc 12:1-8. We are reminded to remember our Creator in the days of our youth before the days of trouble come. Ecc 12:3-7 gives these days come a marvelous poetic description of old age and death. Why is it important to remember our creator in the days of our youth before the days of trouble come?

6. Share your own reflection. Regret? Rejoice? Grateful? What should you do or change while you still have time? What is God speaking to you now? How should you live your life from today onward?
