1.	To what do people often turn in times of sorrow or suffering?
2.	To whom did Peter address the letter? (1 Peter 1:1-2)
3.	Peter refers to his readers as aliens or strangers. What does he mean by this? (1 Chronicles 29:15, Psalm 39:12, Hebrews 13:14) Do you ever feel like a stranger in the world? When? What are the circumstances?
4.	What did Peter say God had given his people? (1 Pet 1:3-4, Hebrews 9:15)
5.	By what are believers shielded? For how long? (1 Pet 1:5)
6.	What exactly is salvation? When does it happen?





7.	What did Peter tell his readers they may have to suffer or endure? What benefit, if any, is there in trials and suffering? (1 Pet 1:6-7, James 1:2-4, Romans 5:3-5)
8.	What did Peter hope his readers had done even though they had not seen Christ? (1 Pet 1:8) Did Peter himself hear Christ speak similar words after the resurrection? (John 20:29)
9.	What did Peter say was the goal of their and your faith? (1 Pet 1:9)
10	.About what did the prophets speak and for what did they search? Whom did Peter say these prophets were serving? (1 Pet 1:10-12)
11	.When was the last time that God used you to serve someone else? How could he use you to serve others in the near future?
