- 1. Read John 14:1-6.
 - a) Why would their "hearts be troubled" (John 14:1)?
 - b) Jesus says that He will "go to prepare a place" (John 14:2-3). Do you find comfort in knowing that? Why?
 - c) If Jesus is "the way", how should you make the decision between God's way and your way? What did you choose? Why?
- 2. Read John 14:6-7.
 - a) Why it is important to know Jesus is "the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6)?
 - b) Is there another "WAY"? Why?
 - c) When we understand Jesus is the ONLY WAY, it should trouble us about the people around us who do not know Jesus. Read Matthew 28:19-20. Who comes to your mind that you can reach out to with the good news of the gospel?
- 3. If Jesus is "the TRUTH", discuss how should you live your life according to "the TRUTH"?
- 4. In John 10, Jesus says: "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." What do you think Jesus meant by "life to the full"?
- 5. How are the way, the truth, and the life related? How do these three ideas interconnect in your experience of following Jesus?
- 6. Which verse studied particularly resonates with you or challenges you? How will you try to live out this verse in the coming week?
