I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life | John 14:1-6 | Pr. Wallace Ong

1. Read John 14:1-6.
 - a) Why would their "hearts be troubled" (John 14:1)?
 - b) Jesus says that He will "go to prepare a place" (John 14:2-3). Do you find comfort in knowing that? Why?
 - c) If Jesus is "the way", how should you make the decision between God's way and your way? What did you choose? Why?
2. Read John 14:6-7.
 - a) Why it is important to know Jesus is "the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6)?
 - b) Is there another "WAY"? Why?
 - c) When we understand Jesus is the ONLY WAY, it should trouble us about the people around us who do not know Jesus. Read Matthew 28:19-20. Who comes to your mind that you can reach out to with the good news of the gospel?
3. If Jesus is "the TRUTH", discuss how should you live your life according to "the TRUTH"?
4. In John 10, Jesus says: "I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full." What do you think Jesus meant by "life to the full"?
5. How are the way, the truth, and the life related? How do these three ideas interconnect in your experience of following Jesus?
6. Which verse studied particularly resonates with you or challenges you? How will you try to live out this verse in the coming week?
