4. How can we mutually encourage each other as Christians today?
5. How does Paul feel about the Gospel?
6. What does verse 17 remind us about the Christian message and the Christian life?

Pray:

- a. Thank God:
  - i. For the church and how it encourages you in faith and obedience.
  - ii. For the truth that God has shown and offered his righteousness in the gospel.
  - iii. The righteousness is always about faith, not performance.
- b. Ask God: to give you boldness in sharing the gospel, and to show you if or when you are ashamed of it.
