1. Christians are saved by grace, and not by works... so why bother obeying God or living a good life?

2. How does Paul explain what he means by “you died to sin” in:
 - a. V3-5

 - b. V5-7

3. Because Christians “died with Christ,” what do we now know (v8-10)?

4. What is the application Paul draws in verses 11-14 for anyone who died with Christ:
 - a. Negatively?

 - b. Positively?

5. “If I fall into sin, it is because I do not realize who I am in Christ.” How is this a good summary of Paul’s message here?

We don't obey God in order to be saved, but because of who we are: united with Christ, slaves of God, and married to Jesus. Why would we not obey?!
