4. What does he say about a different way to be saved in verse 8?
5. What does the passage say more specifically about the different way to be saved now that Jesus has lived, died and risen? (Rom 10:9-13)
6. What should the truths of verses 9-13 lead believers to do? (Rom 10:14-15)
