- 1. Read Romans 12:1-2
 - a. If you had to sum up the Christian's approach to life in a sentence, what would you say?
 - b. What motivation does Paul give in these verses for the hard work of Christian living?
 - c. How do we worship Christ? Why is this both exciting and challenging?
- 2. Read Romans 12:3-8
 - a. How do we think of ourselves with "sober judgment"?
 - b. What should we do with what God has given us? (v 6-8)
- 3. Read Romans 12: 9-21
 - a. How do these verses show us what it means to be a living sacrifice in our relationships within the church? (9-16)
 - b. How do these verses show us what it means to be a living sacrifice in our relationships toward those who persecute the church? (17-21)
- 4. Pray: As a group, hold God's mercy at the cross in your view and praise him for what he achieved for you there. Pray also about your attitude towards: yourselves, your church, your state/country, and society.
