1. Read Jonah 2:1-6

In what sense is Jonah undeserving and helpless when God rescues him?
(Jonah 1, Jonah 2:1-6)

2. Read Ephesians 2:1-10.

- a) In what sense are we undeserving and helpless when God rescued us?

- b) How might knowing this impact the way we relate to:
 - i) God,

 - ii) Other people

3. Read Jonah 2:2-9 and Jonah 3:1-3.

- a) In what positive ways does Jonah respond to God's rescue?

- b) How should we respond to the fact that God has rescued us?

4. Read Jonah 2:7-9.

- a) Where do you witness these in our own lives?

- b) What can we do to cultivate a deeper appreciation of God's grace toward us?

- c) In what practical ways can we express an appreciation of God's grace

Prayer:

- Give thanks that God has saved us even 'when we were dead in our trespasses and sins'.
- Pray that God will help us understand just how undeserving and helpless we are apart from Jesus.
