The Greatest Gift of All by His Spirit | Matthew 1:18-25 | Pr. Mark Tan

1. If a friend was to come up to you and tell you that his fiancé is pregnant and her reason is “through the Holy Spirit”, what would be your first reaction?
2. Joseph could have dragged Mary’s shame out into the streets, but instead he wanted to settle the divorce quietly. What can we learn from this about grace? (v19)
3. Joseph had a 180-degree turnaround when God spoke to him in a dream. What does that inform us about our lives and our relationship God? (vs20-25)
4. What does the Holy Spirit’s involvement inform us about God and the world? (vs 18-20)
5. How is the Holy Spirit introduced in this passage? How does this inform us when wanting to engage with the Holy Spirit? (vs 18-21)
6. What does Joseph and Mary’s participation in the birth of Jesus tell us about God’s grace?
7. What does God’s grace mean to you when He gives you the gift of His Son?
8. Apply: How would you involve God in sharing His grace this Christmas season and for the new year?
