Jesus, Victorious Over His Enemies | Luke 21 | Pr. Mark Tan

1. How were the disciples instructed by Jesus to respond to the coming enemies?
(vv 8,9,28)
2. List the specific trouble that Jesus described would come before his return? (vv 8-28)
3. Which of these things are evident in our world today?
4. What does it look like for me to “be always on watch” practically on a daily basis?
(vv1-4, 29-36)
5. What are the things of this world that I am tempted to worry about or fear? How can this passage help me battle those temptations?
6. Pray for one another:
Heavenly Father, thank You for our victory in the cross of Christ Jesus. I pray Lord, that in all things I may be granted the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Jesus Christ my Lord, and that by Your grace You would open my understanding to know the victory that we have in Him. Open the eyes of my heart to know what is the hope of my calling in Christ. Give me the grace and strength to stand fast in the evil day against the schemes of the devil, so that I may fulfill the tasks that You would have me to do, to Your praise and glory. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Take Home: We can be confident that Jesus defeats His enemies, therefore we should boldly live for Christ, watch for His Victory and proclaim Him in word and deed. (vv1-4, 36-38)
