Kingdom's People – Keeping His Word | Luke 8:16-21 | Pr. Wallace Ong

1. What or whom does the lighted lamp represent in 8:16? Why must the lamp be placed on a lampstand rather than hidden?
2. Think about the parable of the sower, the soils, and the seed from Luke 8:4-15. Think also of the metaphor of light found in Luke 8:16 compare with Luke 8:15. Both verses are about hearing God's word. What have you learned from these verses regarding the good reception of God's word?
3. In view of 8:18, what will happen to the people who think they are Christians, but don't really "get it"? (Luke 19:11-27)
4. Connect Luke 8:16,18,21. What does it mean for you that if you hear God's word and obey it that you are showing that you belong to God's family? (Matthew 7:21-23, James 1:22-24, John 14:23-24)
