Mothers know best | 1 Samuel 1:1-28 | Bro. Prathab

Read 1 Samuel 1:1-28:

1. Share with the group something unique that struck you or encouraged you about Hannah, the mother of prophet Samuel.
2. Like Hannah, mothers are usually mighty prayer warriors. Do you agree? Give reasons or examples.
3. Share with the group about one unique character about your mother. Was she a prayer warrior? A Patient mother? A strict mother? A caring mother? A forgiving mother? A wise mother? Spiritual guide?
4. We are accustomed to addressing God as "Our Heavenly Father". Read Matthew 23: 37-39. How does the imagery of God as a benevolent mother who loves her children and longs to protect them always affect your understanding of God?
5. Mothers (and fathers) are usually very concerned about their children. Mothers naturally worry about their child/children. If you are a mother, can you fully trust God with your children and not worry about them? Share your thoughts.
6. For mothers: Can you lead your children to serve God? Can you lead your children to worship God? What challenges did you face in raising your child/children?
