b. What should we remember in times like that? (Mark 9:28-29, Matthew 17:18-20)

a. How does Jesus’ lament reveal the root problem of that generation?

b. How does Jesus’ lament express the heart and mind of God?

c. What would he say about our faith in Him?

4. When has your faith been challenged? Explain.

a. How have these challenges helped to deepen your faith in God?

b. What was your biggest takeaway from the sermon and passages?

5. What did God say to you through His Word?

a. Will anything in the lesson lead to changes in your life?

b. And what are you going to do about it?
