What Fathers do Best | Deuteronomy 6:4-12 | Pr. Mark Tan

TAKE HOME:

*Fathers, in having and giving **fervent focus, frequent instruction, firm conviction**, should **not forget God's goodness**, which changes everything.*

Read Dt 6:4-9

1. What's the focus of the passage and why is it important for everyone? (vv. 4-6)
2. If you could give sage advice about God to someone under you, what might that be?
How frequent in a week should we share this to others? Think of an actual number. (v. 7)
3. What could verses eight and nine mean symbolically? What practical ways can we carry out that meaning today? (vv. 8-9)

Read Dt 6:10-12

1. What might distract us from remembering God and His goodness? (vv. 10-11)
2. How does God remind Israel of Himself in verse 12? What is the Christian version of verse 12?
