Supremacy of God | Psalm 2 | Bro. Ong Kim Chuan

1. Looking at the Psalm 2 as a whole how would you break it down? What do think are the main points of this Psalm?
2. In what ways do you see the world in rebellion against God and His Word? (vv1-3)
3. It's tempting to be like the earthly kings described here as plotting to get rid of the rule of the King of Israel. Can you point to a time in your life when you wanted to get free from God's rule in your life (v3)?
4. In v6, God explains that it was He who put the king on his throne, therefore, to reject the king is to reject God. Are we living in a time when our culture is wanting "a spirituality" without reference to God's word? What has been your experience? (v 4-6)
5. Since God is sovereign, why doesn't He just send Christ to crush all rebellion and end all the suffering? What wisdom and instruction does the psalmist give to kings and judges? (v10-12) Can a person accept Christ as Savior without accepting Him as Lord?
