2.	How does this parable compare to the following passages?  a) 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6  b) 2 Peter 3:10-12  c) Revelation 3:2-3
3.	What does the oil in the lamps symbolize in this parable? Why didn't the wise virgins share their oil with the foolish virgins?
4.	What is the consequence of being unprepared for the Bridegroom's return? What will be the reward for being prepared and ready to receive the Bridegroom when He does return?
5.	What distractions or challenges might prevent us from staying spiritually prepared? How can we help people be prepared for the most important day they will ever face?



- 6. How can we live lives that honor God, knowing that Christ's return can happen at any moment? How does this parable challenge us to evaluate our priorities and spiritual disciplines?
- 7. What is the significance of the phrase, "Keep watch, because you do not know the day or the hour"?
