1. What are some "losses" you need to embrace for the sake of knowing Christ better and participating in His mission? (Ph 3:7-11)
2. How does understanding justification by faith and not works impact your approach to holy living and engaging in mission? (Ph 3:12-14)
3. How does keeping your eyes on the eternal reward motivate you in your pursuit of holy living and missions? (Ph 3:15-18)
4. What are some contemporary examples of attitudes or behaviors that are "enemies of the cross of Christ"? How can you guard yourself against these influences? (Ph 3:18)
5. How does the hope of future glory motivate you to live a holy life *now*? How does it inspire you to share the hope of transformation with others through missions? (Ph 3:20-21)

*Philippians 3 help us understand holy living and a heart for missions are intertwined.
Let us challenge ourselves prioritize Christ above all else, to press on in our pursuit of holiness,
and to live with an eternal perspective, all of which are essential for the mission of God.*
