- 1) Read 1 Peter 1:13a *Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded*
 - a. How does verse 13, “therefore,” connect to 1 Pet 1:1-12? Share your findings.
 - b. What does it mean to “prepare your minds for action”? What does it mean by “being sober-minded”? Do these two terms mean the same thing?
 - c. How does being sober-minded help us to battle temptations and trials in this life? Please share some examples.

- 2) Read 1 Peter 1:13b *set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.*
 - a. What does “at the revelation of Jesus Christ” mean? (Or refer to) What does it say about the nature of Christians’ hope? And how does Christian hope differ from worldly hope?
 - b. How does our hope (“at the revelation of Jesus Christ”) shape our thoughts or lives?
 - c. How does placing our hope in Christ strengthen our resilience against conforming to the values of this world?
