1. What is the importance of intentional discipleship in fostering holiness and a deep understanding of sound doctrine in the lives of believers? (v1-2)
2. Similar to Timothy, what is our responsibility as disciples in upholding the truth and protecting ourselves and others from teaching that undermines holiness and genuine faith? (v3)
3. What does it mean to be a good steward of the truth of the gospel, and how does this relate to living a life set apart for God and discipling others? (v3-4)
4. How can a misunderstanding or misuse of God's law lead away from holiness rather than towards it? (v5-7)

5. How does examining the list of unholiness challenge our own lives that may not align with God's standard of holiness? How can we use it to disciple others?(v8-10)

6. How does the "gospel concerning the glory of the blessed God" provide the power and motivation for transformed living, moving us disciples away from the practices of the unholy? (v11)
