 - What does Paul teach about treating older men, younger men, older women, and younger women? How do these principles shape our relationships today?
 - How can I treat someone more like spiritual family this week?

- 2. Compassionate Care for Those in Need (Read: 1 Timothy 5:3–16)
 - What qualifies someone as a 'true widow'? How can our church or group better support the vulnerable or lonely?

- 3. Leading and Supporting with Integrity (Read: 1 Timothy 5:17–25)
 - What guidelines does Paul give regarding elders and leadership?
 - How do we honor leaders while also holding them accountable?

- 4. Reflecting Christ in Our Work (Read: 1 Timothy 6:1–2)
 - Why does Paul instruct believers to work respectfully and diligently—even under hardship?
 - How does our work reflect our witness for Christ?
 - What's one way I can demonstrate integrity in my work this week?
