## A Truly Free Malaysian

1. How does a busy Malaysian life—with work, family, and traffic—make it hard to consistently "abide in Jesus's word"? What practical steps can we take to overcome these challenges?
2. Jesus says that knowing the truth sets us free. In what areas of our lives do we still feel enslaved by sin, despite knowing the truth? How can we apply the teachings of John 8:31-32 to find more freedom?
3. How can we, as a care/peer group, help each other remain committed to Christ's teachings when faced with discouragement or spiritual dryness?
4. In what ways can our spiritual freedom in Christ motivate us to be better citizens of Malaysia? What does it look like to serve our country out of a place of true freedom, rather than out of obligation or fear?
5. John 8:36 says, "if the Son makes you free, you will be free indeed." How can this spiritual freedom give us the courage to stand for justice and truth in our Malaysian society, even when it's difficult?
6. How can we, as a group of Malaysian Christians, be a "light" in our community by demonstrating the love of God to those of different faiths and backgrounds? What are some small but meaningful actions we can take this week to build bridges?
