Sermon Title

Psalm Series - My Soul Thirsts for God

I Will Eagerly Seek You

1. David expressed a desperate spiritual thirst for God in the “dry and parched land” (v.1). How does the intensity of his desire challenge you to prioritise seeking God “earnestly” in your own life?
2. David declared that God’s steadfast love is “better than life” (v.3). What does it mean for you that God's covenantal love is more precious and valued, than physical existence itself. How does this affect your worship?
3. Despite being hunted in the wilderness of Judah, David committed himself to praise God with “joyful lips” (v.5) and lifted up his hands. How can David's determined, unreserved praise guide your commitment to worship God even in times of difficulty?
4. David trusted God's protection, affirming that his soul would “cling” to the Lord and be upheld by God's “right hand” (v.8). How does meditating on God’s promise to uphold and shelter you, help you face adversaries or “mouth of liars” (v.11) who seek your ruin?
5. David proclaimed that God's steadfast love (*hesed*) is “better than life” (v. 3) - motivating his deep pursuit of God's “power and glory” (v.2). And the Gospel reveals that God's love demonstrated by Jesus is stronger than death, by being raised up to His throne by God's power. How does reflecting on the resurrected Christ intensify your determination to seek Him daily, and rely on His love for eternal satisfaction and protection?
